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ANNUAL FIFTH COMPETITION REGULATIONS CATEGORIES

Five Ajzā
Fifteen Ajzā
Entire Qurān

FINALISTS

Three finalists are required from each of the participating national regions. Each region should have a maximum of one representative per category.

AGE LIMITATION PER CATEGORY

Five (5) Ajzā	- Fifteen (15) years and under.
Fifteen (15) Ajzā	- Eighteen (18) years and under
Entire Qurān	- Twenty (20) years and under.

Law regarding participants

- All participants must hold a valid South African Identity Document (I.D) and Passport.
- No applicant will be allowed to participate if he is currently studying abroad in any International Institution.
- All previous participants who reached the finals **may not** re - enter the same category previously participated in except those who participated in the entire Qurān category and obtained **no** position.
- All participants who entered a category and **never** advanced past the *preliminaries* **may** re - enter the same category.
- Previous 5Ajzā participants who reached the finals can only enter the 15 Ajzā category even if **no** position was obtained in the previous category.
- Participants in the 15 Ajzā category **will not** be allowed to enter the 5 Ajzā category.
- Those who obtained any of the first three positions in the entire Qurān category **may not** re - enter. Records of all previous participants is available.



Questioning format

Five (5) questions posed to those entering for five (5) Ajzā - one in each juz

Five (5) questions posed to those entering for fifteen (15) Ajzā - one in every three (3) Ajzā

Six (6) questions posed to those entering for the entire Qurān - two (2) in every ten (10) Ajzā.

Marking format

Fifty (50) points are allowed for Hifh / memorization.

Thirty (30) points for Tajweed.

Ten (10) points for pronunciation / Makharij

Ten (10) points for presentation.

Marking rules

- Hifh is out of 50 . Tajweed is out of 30. Makarij is out of 10. Presentation is out of 10.
- Each dot (.) represents a quarter mark deducted and each (—) represents a full mark.
- A quarter mark is deducted for every Tajweed and Maharij mistake.
- A quarter mark is also deducted for doubt (repetition / hesitation) in recitation.
- If a participant make an error and rectifies himself a quarter mark is still deducted.
- If a participant is informed of an error made he has to repeat from start of the verse an a quarter is deducted.
- If after two attempts the participant cannot rectify himself the judge will rectify him and a full mark is deducted.
- If a participant is unable to complete a question a full 20 marks is deducted.
- At the end all the dots and lines are added to give a total that is then deducted from 100 to give a percentage result.
- The mark for presentation is left to the judges judgement. Look at posture, dress, mannerism and recital voice i.e. voice and melody.



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Important note regarding presentation

As representatives of the Holy Qurān, participants dress code , posture when seated and overall mannerisms are taken into consideration along with melody and voice. **No sloppy** dressed and **name –brand** wearing, participants will not be allowed to participate.

International competitions

Winners in each of the three categories should have a **valid** updated **South African passport**. This is not a prerequisite for participation but it will make the participants eligible for consideration for participation in International Competitions. Those who are not in possession of a South African passport should apply for one as soon as possible. Students will be selected for these competitions based on the requirements for the participation forwarded to us by the host of those competitions.

Compulsory

All Students under the age of 18yrs will not be able to travel abroad without an un-bridged birth certificate.
